You may be able to get an ability-to-pay reduction if you can provide proof of income. (You may be subject to civil or criminal penalties if you give fake or incomplete information.)

Services offered through the Center are private and confidential. Staff is required to comply with state and federal regulations regarding the disclosure of client information. You may be assured that every precaution is taken to protect client privacy. Staff is committed to the highest code of conduct and quality of care possible.

SERVICES FOR CLIENTS

CRISIS INTERVENTION-People who are experiencing an emergency, emotional upset, crisis, and addition problems may come to the Center to talk with one of our counselors. You may telephone or come to the Mental Health Center.

After a thorough assessment, you will be told of the treatment available at the Center or at other agencies. Other services offered are psychiatric detention order applications, referrals to other community agencies, and assessment of jail inmates.

SERVICES TO CHILDREN, ADOLESCENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES-Children under 17 and their families are offered a wide array of services at our three centers, in their homes, at local schools, and in other community-based locations.

COUNSELING SERVICES-are available that allow you to talk and explore options in a group, family, or individual setting.

COMMUNITY REHABILITATION-This service is for those people who need long term care. The Center offers case management services, medical services, group activities, supportive employment, transportation, and referrals to a variety of residential care homes.

SERVICES FOR SPECIAL NEEDS CLIENTS

ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUGS-This service addresses issues of recovery for persons with mental illness and addictions.

DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED-This is for the consumer who has mental retardation and a mental illness.

DEAF/HARD OF HEARING-All ages are served by this program for persons who use any form of communication other than the spoken language.

HOMELESS PROGRAM-People identified as homeless and having a mental illness are helped to access housing, shelters, food banks, and other services.

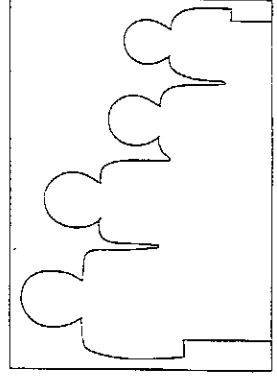

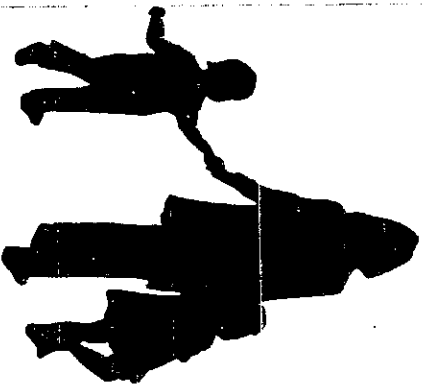
